Practicing at Beare Gill.

Beare Gill can be made available on a limited basis to RRND members, with priority given to those who participate fully in club events.

No access will be given until a disclaimer is signed and logged with the committee member providing the key. There must be a nominated member responsible for the supervision of the party.

There is a charge. £10 for the first machine and £5 for subsequent machines.

Members are not to practice alone and must be accompanied by another person who is capable of raising the alarm in an emergency and liaising with the emergency services and providing access. That person should hold the field gate key. Members must not use the land unless they are familiar with it.

Machines are not to be ridden in the fields or access track and should stay within the stream/woods area. Noise must be kept to a minimum. Vehicles should be parked out of sight if possible for security reasons.

The gates must be kept closed whilst riders are on site.

Please note that access may be withdrawn if circumstances warrant it – in the event of poor ground conditions for example, or overuse.
