CAMPING INFORMATION

Location

Sethern, Rams Lane, Dunsfold, Surrey GU8 4NR

Pitches

There are no set pitches for camping, but please ensure a safe distance between other campers. See map for details.

Facilities

There is clean drinking water available and a combination of portaloo and plumbed in toilets.

Electricity

There will be some power available for electric trials bike and small device charging, but not electric hook ups for caravans/campers.

Food

This is a self catering event. The nearest supermarkets are located in Cranleigh which is 15 minutes drive away.

Dogs

Dogs are allowed, but must be kept under control and all mess cleared up and disposed of.

Waste

There is no waste disposal on site so please ensure that you take home your own rubbish at the end of the weekend.

RIDING INFORMATION

Riding is allowed all weekend, but usual AMCA rules still apply including the use of helmets.

Only trials bikes are permitted to be ridden at the weekend. No MX or other off road vehicles are allowed.

Sethern is a great bit of land with lots of natural and some man made obstacles.

There is also a small ditch/stream that runs at the bottom of the land.

Kids riding

The weekend is a great opportunity for kids to practice and improve. A responsible adult must be on site and be supervising their own children whilst they are riding.

There are lots of flat paths within the woodland to learn.

Riding in the field is permitted but only on the side closest to the woods and away from the main house.

Speed must be kept to a sensible level and should really only be used for young riders to learn the basics before they are ready for the woodland.

Field riding may be restricted if we have a large number of campers and there is not space to safely allow.

SATURDAY PRACTICE TRIAL

Practice Trial with Pete Edwards

Pete will then be on hand to give advice and helpful tips for those who are new to trials and keen to learn the basics.

SUNDAY CLUB TRIAL INFORMATION

On Sunday we hold our August round of the club championship.

The trial sections will most likely be laid out on the Saturday afternoon however those entering the trial must avoid riding the sections before the trial begins.

Usual AMCA rules apply for the trial and all riders must sign on and pay before beginning the trial.

The trial is open to both members and guests.

The club trial usually attracts a good number of day visitors so please be aware that riding in the field will be restricted on this day for safety reasons.

Adult Member - £15

Child Member - £10

Adult Guest - £20

Child Guest - £15

Please be aware that your camping ticket price does not cover entry to the trial and you must pay the above fee to take part in the trial.
